Milling, Paving and Striping for 16th Street NW Bus Lanes Project March 21 through April 1, 2022

(Washington, DC)—The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is advising all stakeholders to expect the continued intermittent closing of northbound and southbound travel lanes along 16th Street NW occurring one lane at a time during **the off-peak hours of 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday**. The following construction activity will take place in the upcoming weeks, weather permitting.

- **16th Street NW from Arkansas Avenue NW to Irving Street NW** – Bus Lane striping operations will take place on **Monday, March 21, 2022 through Friday, April 1, 2022**. Construction activities will take place during off peaks hours from 9:30 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Please adhere to the **Emergency No Parking** signage posted. Striping activities will be completed block by block heading southbound.
- **16th Street NW from Swann Street to W Street NW** - Milling, Paving, and Striping operations will take place from Swann Street NW to W Street NW beginning on **Monday, March 28, 2022**. Construction activities will take place during off peaks hours from 9:30 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Please adhere to the **Emergency No Parking** signage posted.
- **16th Street NW from Euclid Street NW to Swann Street NW** – Crews will perform manhole improvement work from Euclid Street NW to Swann Street NW from **March 17, 2022 through March 25, 2022**. Construction activities will take place during off peaks hours from 9:30 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Please adhere to the **Emergency No Parking** signage posted.

Roadway users should expect short interruptions to two-way traffic. Travel lanes will be tapered as necessary to allow for the safe channelizing of traffic. Temporary sidewalk closures may be required during construction. Pedestrian channelizers, detours, and signage will be installed when these sidewalk closures are needed.

These intermittent lane closures and activities are necessary to complete work related to the 16th Street NW Bus Lanes project from Arkansas Avenue NW to K Street NW.

Traffic controls, including signage, will be in place to guide motorists and pedestrians safely through the work zone. All users of the roadway are advised to stay alert and be observant of signage and work zones while traveling in this area.

Once completed, the 16th Street NW Bus Lanes project will improve the performance and reliability of bus routes and pedestrian access along 16th Street NW from Arkansas Avenue NW to H Street NW.
